Council Member Snider indicated that he had spoken with Public Works Director Ronsko concerning his concerns regarding the Ham Lane and Tokay Street intersection. Public Works Director Ronsko updated the Council on the time frame for the installation of the signals at the subject intersection and that he would not favor the installation of 4-way stops during the interim period. Mr. Ronsko further recommended that red zoning be done in the area to alleviate the apparent site distance problems being encountered.
