RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council award the bid for the rebuilding of derrick/boom truck #116 to Utility Body Company in the amount of \$10,047.21, which includes sales tax.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The specifications for this item were approved by the City Council on February 3, 1982. Bids were opened on Wednesday, February 17, 1982 and the following 2 bids were received.
