PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY (PGandE) hereby gives notice that in Application No. 60225, filed with the California Public Utilities Commission on January 30, 1981, it has requested authorization to increase PGandE's electric rates and charges related to energy costs. The proposed adjustment rates will increase PGandE's electric revenues about 18 percent, or \$176.4 million for the four month period April 1, 1981 to July 31, 1981.
