Council was informed that in order to properly protect traffic on Lodi Avenue, it was determined that it would be necessary to install an interconnection between the signals at the Southern Pacific Railroad Tracks and the California Traction Company tracks. The City will be responsible for 10% of the cost of this interconnection, and TDA Funds have been allocated to match the Federal Funds needed for this project. It is estimated that the City's portion will be \$2,225.

On recommendation of the City Manager, Council adopted the following resolution:

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That City Council adopt a resolution approving the supplement to our existing agreement with the State of California and authorize the City Manager and City Clerk to execute on behalf of the City.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: In order to properly protect traffic on Lodi Avenue, it was determined that it would be necessary to install an interconnection between the signals at the Southern Pacific Railroad tracks and the California Traction Company tracks. The City will be responsible for 10% of the cost of this interconnection, and TDA Funds have been allocated to match the Federal Funds needed for this project. It is estimated that the City's portion will be \$2,225.

It is recommended that the program supplement be approved in order to expedite the completion of this project.

All required signing and marking at RR Xing will be completed in accordance with the requirements of MUTCD, 1978. 3. In agreeing to the construction of this project, the local agency agrees the payment of Federal funds will be limited to the detail estimate amount approved by the Federal Highway Administration in the Federal-Aid Project Agreement (PR-2), or its modification (PR-2A), and accepts any increases in local agency contribution. 4. In executing this Program Supplemental Agreement, local agency hereby reaffirms the "nondiscrimination assurances" contained in the aforementioned Master Agreement for Federal-Aid Program.
