City Clerk Reimche presented a letter which had been received from Phyllis Lamphere, Regional Director of the U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration which stated in part that "as a part of the Administration's economic program, the President will shortly be sending to the Congress a request to rescind a large portion of EDA's fiscal 1981 appropriation and loan guaranty authority. The amount remaining in FY 81 will be sufficient only to fund projects which have already been approved". Accordingly, Ms. Lamphere advised the City of Lodi that its pending project cannot be approved. Since the President will not be requesting program funds for FY 82, hope cannot be held out for funding of the City's project next year.

Dear Mr. Graves:

As a part of the Administration's economic program, the President will shortly be sending to the Congress a request to rescind a large portion of EDA's fiscal 1981 appropriation and loan guaranty authority. The amount remaining in FY 81 will be sufficient only to fund projects which have already been approved. Accordingly, I am advising you that your pending project cannot be approved.
