Council discussed a letter which had been received from Thomas H. Willoughby, Chief Consultant, Assembly California Legislature which reads in part as follows:

"Assemblyman Hannigan has requested me to respond to a request from Speaker Pro Tempore McCarthy that our office bring you up to date about the status of the Agricultural Lands Task Force. The task force has finished its work and has thus been discontinued. It held several meetings to examine various alternatives for preserving agricultural land. Unfortunately, at the end of its deliberations the task force remained quite divided on the question of whether major legislative action was necessary or appropriate at this time to deal with the agricultural land issue.

Because no consensus was produced, the task force issued no reports and published no documents. thus, our office has no accounts of recommendations or proceedings which we can send to you.

Although Assemblyman Hannigan remains keenly interested in preserving agricultural land, there does not appear to be widespread support for major legislation at this time."


