REVIEW OF ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICES

RECOMMENDED ACTION: None required. Information only.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: At its regular meeting of February 18, 1987 the City Council heard a report on a request for funding to assist the area chapter of the Humane Society and Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals. Civil Code Section 607e provides that where such societies are "actively engaged in enforcing the provisions of the laws of this state" in the areas of cruelty to animals and animal control, these societies may petition the appropriate local agency for up to \$500 per month for such services. Following a brief review, the City Council directed that this matter be placed on this agenda for the purpose of discussing animal control services in the City. Attached (Exhibit A) is a copy of the Council Communication prepared for the last regular meeting.
