SUBJECT: CABLE TELEVISION FRANCHISING/REFRANCHISING APPLICATION FILING FEE

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt Resolution No. _____ establishing a cable television franchise/refranchise filing fee of \$5,000.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: As the City Council is aware, King Videocable Company is in the process of responding to the City's Request for Proposal for the refranchising of the local cable television system. Section 5.16.040 of the City's cable television ordinance provides that "an application for a franchise or franchise renewal . . . shall be in writing and accompanied by a payment to the City in an amount to be established and amended from time to time by resolution of the City Council." The information which will be presented by King Videocable in support of its request for franchise renewal will, in some portions be quite technical and could well be beyond the capabilities of the staff to analyze and evaluate. Technical assistance will probably be necessary and the cost of this service should logically be borne by the cable television company. It is unlikely the cost will exceed the recommended filing fee, and the unexpended remainder of the fee would then be returned to the company. I have discussed this with Mr. Richard Shay, Vice President of King Videocable Company, and he has no problem with this approach.

The City Attorney and I will be pleased to answer any questions Councilmembers may have.


