Subject: Declare Stove in Jail as Surplus Property

RECOMMENDATION: Declare gas convection oven in jail surplus property, authorize its sale and the purchase of 2 microwave ovens.

BACKGROUND: The primary meals served prisoners in the jail are prepared frozen means (TV dinners). These are heated in a commercial grade gas oven with a value of \$700.00. It would be much more efficient in terms of time, utilities and sanitation to prepare these meals using microwave ovens.

The City of Ione has raised funds for a commercial grade oven for their community center and would like our oven. They have offered to purchase our oven in an "as is" condition for \$700.00.

The \$700.00 is adequate funds to purchase 2 microwave ovens for use in the jail.
