I am writing on behalf of the Governing Board of Lodi Unified School District to express the district's appreciation for the Lodi City Council's recent adoption of a resolution urging Governor Brown to reconsider his freeze on school construction funds.

Since 1978 school districts have no viable means of generating funds for school construction. We have had to rely on such assistance from the State. Any erosion of previously earmarked funds as evidenced by the Governor's action will pose serious problems for the educational program of all students within the growing Lodi Unified School District, and for the quality of life in the City of Lodi!

We truly appreciate the City Council's recognition of our plight, and look forward to continued mutual cooperation in activities involving the education of children in our community.
