Council, on motion of Council Member Snider, Murphy second,
adopted a Resolution of Appreciation for retiring County
Administrator, Charles E. (Chuck) Dixon.

WHEREAS, Charles E. (Chuck) Dixon, County Administrator of San Joaquin County since July 1973 will retire March 29, 1983.

WHEREAS, Charles E. (Chuck) Dixon began his career in County Government in 1955 in Fresno serving as Administrative Analyst and Assistant County Administrator.

WHEREAS, Charles E. (Chuck) Dixon, during his career, has served as Chief Administrative Officer of Stanislaus County, Chief Deputy Director of the California State Department of Finance, Director of General Services for the State of California and Vice President of the Federal National Mortgage Association.

WHEREAS, Charles E. (Chuck) Dixon served his country during World War II as a P-51 pilot and was a member of the California National Guard from 1949 until his retirement in 1978 at which time he was a Brigadier General in the army and on the staff as J-4 of the Commanding General of the California National Guard.

WHEREAS, Charles E. (Chuck) Dixon has served on numerous important commissions and committees, served as the president of the County Administrative Officers Association of California for 1980 and the National Guard Association of California for 1977-78.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Lodi does hereby extend its sincere best wishes to Charles E. (Chuck) Dixon upon his retirement as County Administrator of San Joaquin County and expresses its profound appreciation to him for his outstanding administrative abilities and for his many years of dedicated service to San Joaquin County.
