

SUBJECT: PURCHASE OF WOOD UTILITY POLES (UD-E82-1)

On Tuesday, March 9, 1982, bids were received and opened for 61 (various size) wood utility poles. These poles will be used for the lighting system at Salas Park, the relocation of facilities for the traffic signal installation at Hutchins Street/Kettleman Lane intersection, the industrial development in the Turner Road/Cluff Avenue area and to replenish the department's stock of poles. A summary of the bids is shown on the attached recap sheet.

Based on the bids received and the department's preference for all Douglas Fir poles (resulting from experience), it is recommended that the bid be awarded to the low bidder providing all Douglas Fir poles, namely Koppers Company, Inc., West Sacramento, CA in the amount of \$17,005.58.

The cost estimate for this purchase was \$27,000.
