SUBJECT: DISCUSSION REGARDING ADOPTION OF FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND FUNDING ALTERNATIVES

PREPARED BY: City Manager

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council review the public information plan for the City's Five-Year Capital Improvement Program and take action as deemed appropriate.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The City Council has reviewed the City's Five-Year Capital Improvement Program, along with recommended funding alternatives. The goal is to have this program in-place shortly after the start of fiscal year 1987-88. As discussed by the City Council earlier, it is important that this program be given wide public exposure. With this in mind, it is recommended that the staff schedule a series of meetings with groups such as key Chamber of Commerce committees, service clubs, the Board of Realtors, and also be available to any and all other organizations which might be interested in hearing the story.

In addition, it is also recommended that at least two general public meetings be held in locations other than City Hall to provide ample opportunity for public input. This public participation will be of value in our final assessment of the Capital Improvement Program as well as consideration of the various funding alternates. The staff welcomes the Council's direction in the organization of this public information effort.
