

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council approve the plans and specifications for the above project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received Wednesday, April 22, 1981.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The paving of Maxwell Street, between Stockton Street and Ackerman Drive was approved in the 1980/81 Capital Improvement Budget with an estimated expenditure of \$23,000.

In general, the work consists of installing the final paving in Maxwell Street which was originally constructed under the City's subdivision paving policy.

The total cost of the project is estimated at \$22,000.
