The U. S. Bureau of the Census has released the final 1980 Census population and housing units for your jurisdiction. They are:

Jurisdiction Name -	CITY OF LODI
Population -	35,221
Housing Units -	14,811

These totals have been released to the Governor and legislature for the purpose of redistricting and fulfilling a mandatory April 1, 1981, deadline.

The Census data provided to the state will be available to local governments in the near future. It will include the counts for the entire state, individual counties, individual cities, as well as for census tracts, city blocks and enumeration districts. The data will be just population totals, including the totals for the following six groups: 1) White, 2) Black, 3) American Indian, Eskimo and Aleut, 4) Asian and Pacific Islands, 5) Other, and 6) Persons of Spanish Origin.

This data will be made available thru the California State Census Data Center and its Regional Data Centers. For more information, please contact the Data Center handling your area as shown on the reverse side of this letter.

I would like to extend my personal appreciation to everyone in the community for the support given to the Census Bureau during the 1980 Census. With this cooperation and assistance the Bureau was able to conduct the best Census ever.
