Dear Sirs,

We are requesting that a h way stop sign be installed at the intersection of E. Tokay and S. Washington for the following reasons:

1. This is a major crossing for children going to and from school all year around.
2. Many vehicles exceed the posted 30 mph speed limit.
3. Cars pulling out from Washington pull out in front of oncoming traffic causing accidents and many near misses.
4. Children have difficulty crossing due to traffic flow.
5. There is now more traffic due to the additional appartments built on the 200 block of E. Tokay.
6. Traffic is further multiplied and congested during the canning season with additional cars and semi-trucks.
7. The intersection of Tokay and Garfield recieved a h-way stop only after a girl was struck and killed. We wish to prevent this before it happens.
8. Many of the accidents at this intersection have not caused over \$500.00 in property damage and have thus gone unreported.

Several children have been nearly hit at this intersection. There are families with children under 10 yrs. of age on three of the four corners of this intersection. When Paula at the Traffic Sign Maintenance office was contacted last summer, she stated a study was being conducted. Does one of our children or perhaps a child in the surrounding neighborhood need to be hit before action is taken? We sincerely hope not. Please give this matter your careful consideration, regardless of the 'study on paper.'


Dear Ms. Turner:
