Council was reminded that the Lodi City Council at its regular meeting of February 20, 1983 adopted Ordinance No. 1345 which establishes and provides for the regulation of burglary and robbery alarm systems within the city of Lodi. Further, the subject Ordinance provides that upon application for an alarm permit, the applicant shall pay a fee as established by resolution of the City Council.

The Ordinance further provides that a commercial alarm permit holder whose system directly connects with the Lodi Police Department shall pay to the City on or before January 1 of each year, a fee as established by resolution of the City Council.

It is Staff's recommendation that a one-time fee of \$25.00 effective July 1, 1985 be established for application for an alarm permit, and that effective immediately a fee of \$60.00 each year be established for the Commercial Alarm permit holder with direct connection to the Lodi Police Department.

COMMERCIAL ALARM PERMIT HOLDER WITH DIRECT CONNECTION TO THE LODI POLICE DEPARTMENT	\$60.00 EACH YEAR EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY
