
RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council award the bid for the Flat Bed Dump Truck to Sanborn Chevrolet in the amount of \$13,943.28, which includes sales tax.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The specifications for this item were approved by the City Council on March 2, 1983. Bids were opened on Wednesday, March 16, 1983, and the following three bids were received:

This dump truck replaces the 1972 GMC dump truck #126 currently being used by the Parks & Recreation Department. The low bid (\$13,943.28) from Sanborn Chevrolet is on a 10,000 gross vehicle weight vehicle; the Sanborn bid of (\$14,478.31) is for a 10,500 gross vehicle weight vehicle; and the Geweke Ford bid of \$14,223.27 is based on a 10,000 gross vehicle weight vehicle.

There was \$12,000 budgeted for this item in the 1982-83 budget. A special allocation has been submitted to the City Manager for the amount of \$1,950. The sale of the old truck should recover \$1,000 - \$1,500.
