

SUBJECT: Plans and Specifications for "HAM LANE & TOKAY STREET TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION"

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council approve the plans and specifications for the above project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received Wednesday, April 20, 1983.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The installation of a traffic signal at Ham Lane and Tokay Street was approved in the 1983 Capital Improvement Budget, with an estimated expenditure of \$90,000.

In general, the work consists of installing a 2 phase, traffic actuated signal with emergency vehicle pre-emption. In order to expedite this project, the City has already purchased the long-lead-time items (poles and controller). We intend to award the contract at the Council meeting the night of the bid opening.

The total cost of the project is estimated at \$86,000.
