Council was apprised that the MOU with the Police Officers Association of Lodi calls for an across the board salary increase equal to 75% of the change in the CPI for urban wage earners and clerical workers, U.S. City Average, measured from August 1985 to February 1986. The August 1985 index was 319.6 and the February index 1986 is 323.2, an increase of 1.13%. 75% of the increase of 1.13% equals .85%. Council adopted Resolution No. 86-59 rescinding Resolution No. 86-48 and authorizing a salary increase of .85% for Police Officers effective April 7, 1986.



RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council rescind Resolution #86-48 which called for a 1.9% salary increase for sworn police officers and authorize an increase of .85%.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The MOU with the Police Officers Association of Lodi calls for an across the board salary increase equal to 75% of the change in the CPI for urban wage earners and clerical workers, U.S. City Average, measured from August 1985 to February 1986. The August 1985 index was 319.6 and the February index 1986 is 323.2, an increase of 1.13%. 75% of the increase of 1.13% equals .85%.

When we prepared the last Council resolution, we were told the February index was 327.5 which is the index for urban consumers.
