The Lodi Senior Citizens Commission is actively involved in identifying and addressing the needs of senior citizens in the Lodi community.

Our goal in reaching out to the seniors in our community has been greatly impacted by lack of funds for the Lodi Senior Citizens Commission.

For the past three years our commission has provided an informational seminar on aging issues, printed the Lodi Senior Resource Guide, and teamed up with the Alzheimer's Association in providing family caregiver training. All of these efforts come with a cost for advertising, printing, refreshments, and more.
