

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt a resolution approving Program Supplement No. 21 to the Local Agency - State Agreement, approve a special allocation for \$6,000, and authorize the City Manager and City Clerk to execute the agreement on behalf of the City of Lodi.


BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This agreement covers the installation of railroad grade crossing protection at Loma Drive. The improvements will be made by Southern Pacific Railroad Company and include the installation of automatic gates with cantilever flashing lights to replace the existing warning devices and circuitry to control interconnecting this crossing with the California Street, Ham Lane and Turner Road crossings.

Federal funds cover 90% of the project. The City is responsible for 10% which is estimated to be \$13,800. TDA funds in the amount of \$8,000 have been budgeted for this project. An additional \$6,000 will have to be appropriated to cover the estimated cost.



All required signing and marking at RR Xing will be completed in accordance with the requirements of MUTCD, 1978. 3. In agreeing to the construction of this project, the local agency agrees the payment of Federal funds will be limited to the detail estimate amount approved by the Federal Highway Administration in the Federal-Aid Project Agreement (PR-2), or its modification (PR-2A), and accepts any increases in local agency contribution. 4. In executing this Program Supplemental Agreement, local agency hereby reaffirms the "Nondiscrimination Assurances" contained in the aforementioned Master Agreement for Federal-Aid Program.
