**REPLACEMENT OF  
DAMAGED POLICE  
VEHICLE APPROVED**

Council was apprised that on March 24, 1982, an unmarked police vehicle, a 1979 Ford Granada was involved in an accident and sustained approximately \$3,100 damage. The vehicle has over 65,000 miles, with a Blue Book value of \$3,925. Council was respectfully requested to authorize the purchase of a used vehicle to replace the damaged one.

On motion of Mayor Pro Tempore Murphy, Olson second, Council authorized the purchase of a used vehicle to replace a damaged unmarked police vehicle at a cost not to exceed \$7,000.

RECOMMENDATION:


The City Council authorize the purchase of a used vehicle to replace a damaged unmarked police vehicle at a cost not to exceed \$7,000.

BACKGROUND:

On March 24, 1982; an unmarked police vehicle, a 1979 Ford Granada, was involved in an accident and sustained approximately \$3100 damage. The vehicle has over 65,000 miles, with a Blue Book value of \$3925.

Council is respectfully requested to authorize the purchase of a used vehicle to replace the damaged one. Purchase will be made from local dealers or from Hertz or Avis automobile rental. A similar replacement vehicle should be available for no more than \$7,000.
