



BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This project is the first phase of a water system upgrade project which included new mains and hydrants in Church Street from 900' N/Vine Street to Tamarack Drive, and Park Street from 200' W/Church to School Street. Work was to be by City forces. It is recommended that this phase be done by contract in order to have it done prior to the street overlay scheduled for this fall.
