





§ 50443. Authority; nonuse; order; evidence. Upon the petition of an interested person or upon its own motion, the legislative body may also vacate an easement:

(a) If it has not been used for the purpose for which it was dedicated or acquired for five consecutive years next preceding the proposed vacation, or

(b) If the date of dedication or acquisition is less than five years and more than one year, and the easement was not used continuously since that date.

The order of vacation pursuant to this section shall state the period during which the easement or part of an easement has not been used and that the easement or part vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use. The resolution is prima facie evidence of the facts of non-use stated. (Added Stats.1949, c. 81, p. 266, § 1.)
