The plans and specifications for Pleasant Avenue Curb and Gutter Replacement, Lodi Avenue to Walnut" were presented for Council's approval. In general, the work consists of replacing all curb and gutter in the subject block, some tree removal and minor storm drainage work. The project originally included some work on the south side of Walnut west of Pleasant. During the design process, it was determined that this work was not really necessary and it was dropped from the project.

COUNCIL APPROVED THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR "PLEASANT AVENUE CURB AND GUTTER REPLACEMENT, LODI AVENUE TO WALNUT" AND AUTHORIZED THE CITY CLERK TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS THEREON.

SUBJECT: Plans and Specifications for Pleasant Avenue Curb and Gutter Replacement

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council approve the plans and specifications for "Pleasant Avenue Curb and Gutter Replacement, Lodi Avenue to Walnut," and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received Wednesday, May 20, 1981.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The reconstruction of curb and gutter between Lodi and Walnut was approved in the 1979-80 Capital Improvement Budget with an estimated expenditure of \$54,400.

In general, the work consists of replacing all curb and gutter in the above block, some tree removal and minor storm drainage work. The project originally included some work on the south side of Walnut west of Pleasant. During the design process, it was determined that this work was not really necessary and was dropped from the project. The total cost of the project is estimated at \$48,000.
