No. 1311 - An Ordinance rezoning 800 South Beckman Road and 901 through 1123 East Vine Street from C-M, Commercial-Light Industrial to M-1, Light Industrial and certifying that the filing of a Negative Declaration by the Community Development Director was adequate environmental documentation on this project having been introduced at a regular meeting of the Lodi City Council held May 2, 1984 was brought up for passage on motion of Council Member Reid, Olson second. ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL DISTRICT MAP OF
THE CITY OF LODI AND THEREBY REZONING 800 SOUTH
BECKMAN ROAD, LODI, CALIFORNIA, AND 901 THROUGH
1123 EAST VINE STREET, LODI, CALIFORNIA, FROM
C-M, COMMERCIAL LIGHT INDUSTRIAL TO M-1, LIGHT
INDUSTRIAL

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. - The Official District Map of the City of Lodi adopted by Section 27-2 of the City Code of the City of Lodi is hereby amended by rezoning 800 South Beckman Road, Lodi, California, and 901 through 1123 East Vine Street, Lodi, California, from C-M, Commercial Light Industrial to M-1, Light Industrial.

Section 2. - The Negative Declaration for this project as filed by the Community Development Director is hereby certified as adequate environmental documentation for the project.

The alterations, changes, and amendments of said Official District Map of the City of Lodi herein set forth have been approved by the City Planning Commission and by the City Council of this City after public hearings held in conformance with provisions of Chapter 27 of the Code of the City of Lodi and the laws of the State of California applicable thereto.

Section 3. - All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.

Section 4. - This ordinance shall be published one time in the "Lodi News Sentinel", a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi and shall be in force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage and approval.
