ACTIONS REGARDING
AUGUST 25, 1981
SPECIAL ELECTION

RES. NO. 81-55

Following introduction of the matter by City Clerk Reimche, Council took the following actions pertaining to the Special Election called for by the City Council under Resolution No. 81-54:

- a) On motion of Mayor Pro Tempore Murphy, Katnich second, Council set the election date for the subject election on Tuesday, August 25, 1981.
- b) On motion of Councilman Katnich, Murphy second, Council approved Special Allocation in the amount of \$15,000 thereby appropriating funds for the cost of the aforementioned Special Election.
- c) On motion of Councilman Katnich, Murphy second, Council approved a proposed Contract with the County of San Joaquin for certain services to

be provided by the County for the August 25, 1981 Special Election and authorized the Mayor and City Clerk to execute the agreement on behalf of the City.

- d) On motion of Councilman Pinkerton, McCarty second, Council adopted Resolution No. 81-55 allowing for rebuttal argument to be placed on the ballot for the August 25, 1981 Special Election.
