Notice thereof having been published, an affidavit of publication being on file in the office of the City Clerk, Mayor Reid called for the Public Hearing to consider the San Joaquin County Solid Waste Management Plan.

City Manager Peterson advised the Council that the Solid Waste Management and Resource Recovery Act of 1972 requires each County, in cooperation with the affected local jurisdictions, to prepare a comprehensive, coordinated solid waste management plan. State Administrative Code Section 17144 requires every city council to hold a public hearing or meeting prior to approving the plan by resolution.

Mr. Tom Horton, the County's Solid Waste Manager was in attendance and presented an indepth report regarding the subject document and responded to questions regarding the matter as were posed by the Council.

A very lengthy discussion followed with Council Member Pinkerton asking that the record show his concern that if the plan was adopted, the County Board of Supervisors would dictate costs and fees.

Numerous questions were directed to Mr. Horton and to Staff regarding the matter.

Following additional discussion, on motion of Council Member Snider, Pinkerton second, Council continued the subject Public Hearing to the next Regular Council meeting and directed Public Works Director Ronsko to flag and highlight, for the benefit of the Council, all paragraphs and pages within the subject document that are applicable to the City of Lodi.


COMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council hold a public hearing on the draft San Joaquin County Solid Waste Management Plan and take action as deemed appropriate.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The Solid Waste Management and Resource Recovery Act of 1972 requires each County, in cooperation with the affected local jurisdictions, to prepare a comprehensive, coordinated solid waste management plan. The plan has been prepared and copies were presented to the City Council at its regular meeting of May 21, 1986. State Administrative Code Section 17144 requires every city council to hold a public hearing or meeting prior to approving the plan by resolution. A copy of the appropriate resolution is attached (Exhibit A).

The County of San Joaquin advises that the action of the City Council should not contain qualifying statements such as "approve in principle" or "approve in concept".

Mr. Tom Horton, the County's Solid Waste Manager, will be in attendance at Wednesday night's meeting to present the report and answer questions from the City Council and the public.

RESOLUTION ADOPTING TRIENNIAL REVIEW SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Nejedly-Z'berg-Dills Solid Waste Management and Resource Recovery Act of 1972 (hereinafter referred to as the Act) requires each County in cooperation with affected local jurisdictions to prepare a comprehensive, coordinated solid waste management plan; and

WHEREAS, said Act also requires that the County Solid Waste Management Plan be reviewed and revised, if appropriate, at least every three years and revised where necessary to be consistent with state policy; and

WHEREAS, said Act also requires that any amendments to said plan shall be subject to the approval by a majority of the cities within the County which contain a majority of the population of the incorporated area of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Joaquin has prepared an update to said plan for solid waste management in conformance with the Act and on May 27, 1986 submitted said plan update to this Council for approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Lodi has reviewed and approved said plan update.
