Dear Judge Seibly:

Earlier this year the Lodi City Council took action to establish permit parking on City streets in the area of the Pacific Coast Producers' cannery. The effective date of the enforcement was interpreted by the City staff to be June 1, 1986. Enforcement did in fact begin on Monday, June 2, and a number of citations were written on that day and the following two days.

At its regular meeting of June 4, 1986, the City Council directed the staff to cease writing citations in favor of issuing warning notices through June 30, 1986. It is the Council's feeling that this warning period will give the residents of that area some time to become accustomed to the regular parking patrol there.

The purpose of this letter is to respectfully request the dismissal of those parking citations issued to residents in this permit parking area on the days of June 2, 3 and 4, 1986. The numbers of these citations are listed on the attached page (Exhibit A). This request is made in the spirit of assisting those residents in whatever way possible to ease a congested parking problem there. It was the residents themselves who requested these parking restrictions, and it is the City Council's belief that the grace period requested is appropriate.

On behalf of the City Council, I extend the City's appreciation of your time, and urge your favorable consideration of this request. We hope it does not result in a major inconvenience for you and your staff.
