

SUBJECT: EXCEPTION TO RES. NO. 82-30 WHICH WOULD ALLOW, FOR ONE TIME ONLY, THE
CHAIRMAN TO SERVE A THREE-YEAR CONSECUTIVE TERM ON THE LODI ARTS COMMISSION

Under the heading of "Chairman", Resolution No. 82-30 - A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lodi establishing a Lodi Arts Commission in the City of Lodi provides that "after the first year, the fifteen members of the Commission will, by a majority vote, elect the Chairman from among their number".

Further, the Resolution provides that the Chairman shall serve at the pleasure of the City Council, but not in excess of two consecutive years per term.

The members of the Lodi Arts Commission have indicated their desire to have Gwinnett Mitchell serve another term as chairman. In order for this to be possible, it will be necessary for the Lodi City Council to adopt a Resolution granting a one-time exception to Resolution No. 82-30, thereby allowing Gwinnett Mitchell to serve a third consecutive term as chairman.


