PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY (PGandE) has filed Amended Application No. 84-04-028 in which it requests authority from the California Public Utilities Commission, effective August 1, 1984, to increase electric rates by approximately \$816.3 million on an annualized basis.

The proposal requests authority to: (1) increase electric rates under the Energy Cost Adjustment Clause (ECAC) by approximately \$848.6 million on an annualized basis; (2) decrease electric rates by approximately \$84.8 million on an annualized basis to reflect amortization of the balance in the Electric Revenue Adjustment Mechanism (ERAM) account; (3) increase electric rates recovered through the Annual Energy Rate (AER) by approximately \$53.2 million on an annualized basis to recover certain energy-related costs forecasted to be incurred during the 12-month period commencing August 1, 1984; and (4) decrease electric rates by approximately \$0.7 million on an annualized basis as provided for by the Steel Surcharge Adjustment Clause (SSAC).

For the 12-month period beginning August 1, 1984, the requested rate adjustments will increase PGandE's electric revenues by approximately 20.1 percent above the level generated by electric rates in effect as of April 18, 1984.

The requested revisions to the ECAC, ERAM, AER and SSAC rates will not raise PGandE's Electric Department rate of return above the level last found reasonable for that department by the California Public Utilities Commission.
