BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Due to the downtown construction in the area of Pine and Sacramento, and the fact that signals will soon be installed at this location, stop signs were installed on an emergency basis. This action makes these signs legal.

All four stop signs at this location will be removed with the installation of the signals which are included in the downtown improvement project.
