ORDINANCE NO. 1287

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL DISTRICT MAP OF  
THE CITY OF LODI AND THEREBY AMENDING PD(23)  
PLANNED DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT NO. 23 WHICH IS  
LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF LOWER SACRAMENTO ROAD,  
LODI, NORTHERLY OF THE FUTURE EXTENSION OF WEST ELM  
STREET, LODI, BY SUBSTITUTING SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL  
FOR 11.5 ACRES OF PREVIOUSLY APPROVED MULTIPLE-FAMILY  
RESIDENTIAL

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. - The Official District Map of the City of Lodi adopted by Section 27-2 of the City Code of the City of Lodi is hereby amended by amending PD(23) Planned Development District No. 23 which is located on the west side of Lower Sacramento Road, Lodi, northerly of the future extension of West Elm Street, Lodi, by substituting single-family residential for 11.5 acres of previously approved multiple-family residential.

The alterations, changes, and amendments of said Official District Map of the City of Lodi herein set forth have been approved by the City Planning Commission and by the City Council of this City after public hearings held in conformance with provisions of Chapter 27 of the Code of the City of Lodi and the laws of the State of California applicable thereto.

Section 2. - All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.






