City Clerk Reimche presented a letter which had been received from Pacific Gas and Electric Company giving notice that in Application No. 82 06 09, it has requested authorization, effective August 1, 1982 to decrease electric rates under the ECAC tariff and requesting authority to establish an Electric Revenue Adjustment Mechanism (ERAM) rate in accordance with Public Utilities Commission Decision No. 93887, and to establish an Annual Energy Rate in accordance with Decision 92496.

TO: THE STATE, COUNTY AND CITY OFFICIALS AND  
INTERESTED PARTIES

Pacific Gas and Electric Company hereby gives notice that in Application No. 82 06 08 it has requested authorization effective August 1, 1982, to decrease electric rates under the ECAC tariff. PGandE also requests authority to establish an Electric Revenue Adjustment Mechanism (ERAM) rate in accordance with Public Utilities Commission Decision No. 93887, and to establish an Annual Energy Rate in accordance with Decision No. 92496.

The requested August 1 rate adjustments would decrease electric revenues about 4 percent or approximately \$158 million for the 12-month period beginning August 1, 1982.

The ECAC and other rate adjustments will not raise PGandE's Electric Department rate of return above the level of 12.2 percent last found reasonable for PGandE's Electric Department by the California Public Utilities Commission.


