Council was apprised by the City Attorney and City Clerk of the recent legislative changes affecting the Political Reform Act of 1974 which broadened the scope of "Designated Employees" who must file Statements of Economic Interest. Following discussion with questions being directed to Attorney Stein and City Clerk Reinche, Council, on motion of Council Member Reid, Hinchman second, adopted Resolution No. 84-087 amending Resolution No. 81-150 as to the "Designated Employees" who must file Conflict of Interest filings within the City of Lodi pursuant to recent legislative amendments to the Political Reform Act.

RESOLUTION NO. 84-052

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING PASSAGE OF AB 2894 (CONDIT)
WHICH WOULD GIVE CITIES GREATER CONTROL OF SAFETY ON
RESIDENTIAL COLLECTOR STREETS

WHEREAS, AB2894 would amend the vehicle code to allow for 30 mph radar speed limits on streets that qualify for 25 mph non-radar limits.

WHEREAS, the intent of AB2894 is to give local governments the authority to set "prima facie" speed limits on residential collector streets and to use radar to enforce those speed limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Lodi does hereby support passage AB2894.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Lodi does hereby direct the City Clerk to forward certified copies of this Resolution to Mayor Peggy Mensinger, Mayor of the City of Modesto, Assemblyman Condit, and Assemblyman Isenberg.
