DISCUSSION OF  
DIAL-A-RIDE  
AGREEMENT

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the agreement between the City of Lodi and the City Cab Company for Dial-a-Ride service. Assistant City Manager Glenn advised the City Council that the existing agreement will expire June 30, 1989, and provides for extensions only on a full-year basis. Because the City Cab Company was recently sold, and the company has requested a rate increase, the Assistant City Manager said he needed some time to evaluate the operation and the requested rate adjustment. He recommended that the City Council let the existing agreement expire and in its place approve a rolling 30-day agreement which would be automatically renewed every 30 days until a decision is reached. The new agreement prepared by the City Attorney contains the same terms and conditions as the existing agreement.

On motion of Councilmember Reid, Councilmember Olson second, the City Council approved a rolling 30-day agreement between the City of Lodi and the City Cab Company for Dial-A-Ride Services.
