Dear Mr. Graves:

Persuant to the San Joaquin County Council of Government's "1981-82 Unmet Transportation Needs" hearing of March 24, 1981, the COG Executive Board determined that for Fiscal Year 1981-82 there are unmet transportation needs in the City of Lodi that can reasonably be met with available state mandated resources under the Transportation Development Act.

The finding was that:

"The City of Lodi has unmet needs until such time as they provide data demonstrating that the quality of the Dial-a-Ride has been improved to the satisfaction of the COG Board."

Lodi's FY 1981-82 TDA Claim should include a proposal for improving the Dial-a-Ride system in the Lodi area.
