ORDINANCE AMENDING
CITY COUNCIL
SALARY SCHEDULE

ORD. NO. 1360
INTRODUCED

Council was informed that recent amendments to the State of California Government Code allows for an increase in the salaries for council members. In cities over 35,000 up to and including 50,000 in population each member of the council can receive \$400.00 per month. Very recently passed legislation allows for a much earlier implementation date than was previously set forth.

City Manager Peterson explained the latest revisions to this code section and responded to questions as were posed by the Council.

Following discussion, on motion of Council Member Snider, Pinkerton second, Council introduced Ordinance No. 1360 - Ordinance amending City Council salary schedule effective April 15, 1986.

Attached you will find a draft ordinance, which pursuant to recent amendments to the State of California Government Code, allows for an increase in the salaries for council members. In cities over 35,000 up to and including 50,000 in population, each member of the council can receive \$400.00 per month.

The Government Code of the State of California further provides that salary increases cannot become effective until such time as a member of the council commences a new term. Therefore, it is in order for the City Council to pass on this ordinance; however, the increase in salary will not become effective until the official canvass of the 1986 Councilmatic election has been accepted, and the council members elected have been sworn in.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Council introduce Ordinance Amending Lodi Municipal Code Chapter 2, City Council Salaries (Title 2, Chapter 2.08) as authorized by Government Code Section 36516 (a) (2).
