The Plans and Specifications for "Hutchins Street and Harney Lane Traffic Signal" were presented for Council's perusal. Council was apprised that in general, the work consists of installing traffic actuated signal with separate left turn phases, lighting, and street name signs. In addition to the signal contract, informal bids for shoulder widening on the south side of Harney Lane west of Hutchins Street will be obtained. This work was not included in the original estimate and is needed to provide room for a left turn lane.

COUNCIL APPROVED THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR "HUTCHINS STREET AND HARNEY LANE TRAFFIC SIGNAL" AND AUTHORIZED THE CITY CLERK TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS THEREON.

SUBJECT: Plans and Specifications for HUTCHINS ST. & HARNEY LANE TRAFFIC SIGNAL

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council approve the plans and specifications for "HUTCHINS ST. & HARNEY LANE TRAFFIC SIGNAL," and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received Wednesday, July 29, 1981.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The installation of traffic signals at Hutchins St. and Harney Lane was approved in the 1980-81 Capital Improvement Budget with an estimated expenditure of \$53,000 of City TDA funds and \$17,000 of County funds.

In general, the work consists of installing traffic actuated signal with separate left turn phases, lighting, and street name signs. In addition to the signal contract, informal bids for shoulder widening on the south side of Harney Lane west of Hutchins Street will be obtained. This work was not included in the original estimate and is needed to provide room for a left turn lane.

The total cost of the project is estimated at \$98,000. A special allocation will be requested after we have received bids.
