- (1) 25 MPH signs on Aspen Grove Drive as well as on Gateway Circle.
- (2) A STOP or YIELD sign on Ridge Drive and Aspen Grove Drive intersection.
- (3) Parking in front of or too close to fire hydrants. Are the curbs bordering fire hydrants supposed to be painted red?
- (4) On the West side of Church Street between Kettleman and Century the growth of trees so far out in to the street area seems to create traffic problems not only for vehicles, but pedestrian and bicycle travel.
- (5) In the Banyan, Meadow Drive, Vineyard, and Gateway Cr. Streets, many people park their cars on part of the sidewalks.
