
RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council approve the plans and specifications for the above project and authorize advertisement for bids thereon.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This project consists of the construction of new restrooms in the girls' gym and the installation of the main water line and two fire hydrants on-site.

The project estimate is broken down as follows:

Restrooms	\$36,000
Fire protection	26,000
Inspection/Misc.	3,000
	<u>\$65,000</u>


It is understood that the \$15,000 budgeted amount was a rough informal figure obtained from an architect. This figure now appears to be incorrect. Initially the project was only the construction of restrooms in the girls' gym. Once the plans were reviewed by the Fire Marshal, there was an additional requirement of on-site fire hydrants which in turn required the extension of on-site 6" watermain.






