Public Works Director Ronsko reported on a letter which had been received from Gottlieb G. Kammerer, 1424 Reiman Street, Lodi, California complaining about the condition of the sidewalk on the south side of Lockeford Street beginning at the entrance way to the Trailer Park and up to the parking lot of Sell Rite Market indicating that repairs would be the responsibility of the subject property owners. Mr. Ronsko indicated that he would contact Mr. Kammerer and advise him of the City's policy in such matters.

Greetings:

We in our neighborhood are grateful for the repair work done to the faulty sidewalk corner at Cross and Lockeford Street. However I have been asked by several neighbors to call your attention to another problem that exists on the South side of Lockeford beginning at the entrance way to the Trailer park and up to the parking lot of Sell Rite Market.

It is very rough and the low points near the curb to the highest point must equal at least 8 inches or even a foot. The condition of the surface (dirt) is very bumpy and sloping toward the street. We feel that there should be a sidewalk installed so that the elderly and handicapped not to mention the numerous kids could walk towards the market without having their eyes glued to the surface immediately in front of them.

We have a wonderful City and wish to contribute ideas to improve it so there will be less griping and there will be a feeling that they up at city hall do care.
