SUBJECT: Hutchins Street and Harney Lane Traffic Signal Installation

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council award the bid for the above project to Steiny and Company, Inc., the low bidder, in the amount of \$94,624.00, subject to San Joaquin County concurrence and that Council appropriate an additional \$26,000.00 to the project from the City's TDA fund.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Plans and specifications for this project were approved by the City Council on July 15, 1981. Bids were opened on Wednesday, July 29, 1981 and the following 7 bids were received:

This project is being funded by 75% City Transportation Development Act funds and 25% San Joaquin County road funds. The total cost of the project is estimated at \$105,000, which includes some pavement widening on the south side of Harney Lane west of West Lane by separate informal contract. The City's share will be \$78,750, of which \$53,000 is already budgeted.

The high project cost is mainly due to labor and material price increases that have occurred since the project was originally estimated in 1979/80. The project also includes "Opticom" emergency vehicle preemption, left turn signals and the above mentioned street work which was not in the original estimate.

Due to the high number of accidents at this location, it is strongly recommended that the contract be awarded and the additional funds be appropriated. We are presently seeking County approval and will hopefully have more information at the Council meeting.

Reference is made to your letter of July 29, 1981, relative to the proposed traffic signal installation at the intersection of Hutchins Street and Harney Lane.


