
RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approve the naming of the concession building at Salas Park "Art Nelson Concession Stand," or a similar name reflective of Mr. Nelson, i.e. "Nelson's Dugout."

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The Parks and Recreation Commission was approached at their July meeting by Boosters of Boys/Girls Sports President Bob Casalegno and Committee Member Ed Wall with a request that the concession stand at Samuel D. Salas Park be named after Mr. Art Nelson.

Mr. Nelson has served the B.O.B.S. and the community's youth above and beyond the call of duty in his various capacities as a B.O.B.S. Executive Board member for 17 years, a volunteer coach of youth sports teams for 17 years, B.O.B.S. Board president in 1974, Pop Warner youth football local and league president for 12 years, B.O.B.S. tournament coordinator for 12 years, Babe Ruth baseball assistant director for 5 years and director for 7 years, as well as the first concession manager of the B.O.B.S. concession operation at Salas Park, which he ran for two years.

It is for this reason that the B.O.B.S. and the Parks and Recreation Commission recommend the approval of this request.

If the request is approved, the B.O.B.S. organization would appreciate the latitude to name the concession building an appropriate name, tying Nelson's name into it one way or another.


RESOLUTION NAMING THE SALAS PARK CONCESSION STAND
