Subject: Surplus Radio Equipment

We have nineteen (19) Motorola mobil radios and other equipment in storage (refer to attached list). Seven radios and one Handie-Talkie were Lodi Fire Department equipment. One base station was Civil Defense and the other was probably Public Works. The balance was removed from our agency's vehicles.

I have received all of the equipment with Motorola and determined that none of it is of any use to the City since the renovation of our radio systems. I would like to request that this property be declared surplus and be disposed of.


In checking into the disposition of this type of equipment, I find that it yields very little at public auction. San Joaquin County received about five dollars each for the last mobile radios they sold and they later found that some were put to use in private business - in spite of the fact that this is illegal under FCC rules and papers were signed to that effect. It would seem much more appropriate to put them into public safety service, even if we realize nothing from it.

These radios are VHF Highband and can be made to work on a limited range basis with existing equipment in some San Joaquin County rural fire districts where funds are drastically limited. Thornton Fire, for example, does not have radios. Waterloo-Morada is in good condition while, I am told, Victor is suffering.

In view of the above, I recommend that this radio equipment be turned over to the Communications Officer of San Joaquin County General Services for distribution to rural fire districts where it can best be utilized for public safety services.

Please give this matter your consideration and, if you deem it appropriate, pass this recommendation along in order that this property may be disposed of expediently.
