SUBJECT: School Crossings Vicinity Century Schools

RECOMMENDED ACTION: That the City Council adopt a resolution establishing school crossings across Century Blvd. on the west side of Scarborough Drive, and across Scarborough Drive on the south side of Century Blvd. (See attached Exhibit A.) The installations would also include standard pavement marking legends and street signs to warn motorists of the crossings.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Pastor Gordon Elmes of Century Assembly Church has requested the crossings. The crossings would be used by children living north of Century Blvd. and attending Century Schools. Pastor Elmes estimates that in the next school year approximately 100 students will use the crossings daily. The Engineering Division recommends the request be granted.
