PREZONING OF
SUNWEST IV
APPROVED

Ordinance No. 1292 - An Ordinance prezoning Sunwest IV, a 52.6 acre mixed Residential or Residential-Institutional Project proposed for the east side of Lower Sacramento Road, Lodi, one-quarter mile north of Kettleman Lane, Lodi, California to P-D (25), Planned Development District No. 25 with the following conditions having been introduced at a regular meeting of the Lodi City Council held August 3, 1983 was brought up for passage on motion of Council Member Pinkerton, Murphy second. Second reading of the Ordinance was then omitted after reading by title, and the Ordinance was then adopted and ordered to print by the following vote:

- a) that the single-family areas in the project conform to the City's R-1, Single-Family Residential District;
- b) that the cluster homes development be limited to 15 units per acre and conform to the City's R-GA, Garden Apartment Residential District.

ORDINANCE NO. 1292

AN ORDINANCE PREZONING TO P-D (25), PLANNED DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT NO. 25 WITH CONDITIONS SUNWEST IV, A 52.6 ACRE MIXED RESIDENTIAL OR RESIDENTIAL-INSTITUTIONAL PROJECT PROPOSED FOR THE EAST SIDE OF LOWER SACRAMENTO ROAD, LODI, ONE-QUARTER MILE NORTH OF KETTLEMAN LANE, LODI

The City Council of the City of Lodi does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The property hereinafter described is hereby prezoned and classified as being in the Planned Development District No. 25 (P-D 25) for a mixed Residential or Residential-Institutional Project with the following conditions:

- a. that the single-family areas in the project conform to the City's R-1, Single-Family Residential District;
- b. that the cluster homes development be limited to 15 units per acre and conform to the City's R-GA, Garden Apartment Residential District.

Viz:

A portion of the southeast Quarter of Section 10, Township 3 North Range 6 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a railroad spike at the center of said Section 10, said spike also being on the center line of Lower Sacramento Road; thence South 89° 12' 30" East 40.00 feet along the northerly line of said Southeast 1/4 of the east line of said Lower Sacramento Road; thence South 200.00 feet along said east line, to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence along the following six courses: (1) South 89° 12' 30" East, 877.00 feet; (2) South 200.00 feet; (3) South 89° 12' 30" East, 1725.00 feet to the east line of said Section 10; (4) South 0° 0' 30" East, 921.85 feet along said east line; (5) North 89° 13' 54" West, 2602.18 feet to the east line of said Lower Sacramento Road; (6) North 1122.87 feet along said east line to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING, containing 52.6 acres, more or less.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinance in conflict herewith are repealed insofar as such conflict may exist.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published one time in

the "Lodi News Sentinel", a daily newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi and shall be in force and take effect thirty days from and after its passage and approval.
