Dear Mayor Reid:

The San Joaquin County Department of Aging again invites you to appoint a representative from the City of Lodi to the County Commission on Aging for a three year term of membership commencing from and continuing to June 30, 1985.

The Older Californian's Act recently passed by the California Legislature, in addressing advisory councils, provided for "no more than 50% of the council's membership shall be appointed by one official or body of officials".

In order to comply with the provision of the Older Californians Act, the following composition for the Commission on Aging was proposed:

10 members appointed by the Board of Supervisors (2 from each Supervisorial District); 6 members appointed by the respective City Councils within San Joaquin County (1 from each city -- Stockton, Lodi, Tracy, Manteca, Escalon, Ripon); 5 representatives of agencies serving seniors.

The revised San Joaquin County Commission on Aging composition requirements are now in effect. The Commission on Aging, by federal law, must reflect the county's makeup in relation to minority and low income representation. Your assistance in helping meet this grid requirement will be appreciated.

The Commission on Aging has reserved a vacancy for a City of Lodi representative since July 1, 1981; a suggested appointment is for a low income senior, 60 years or older.

The Commission meets the first Monday of every month at 3:00 in the afternoon in the Canlis Administration Building in Stockton. Typical agenda items include:

1. Review and act upon recommendations by the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) regarding funding proposals submitted by agencies and groups in the County. Advise County Department of Aging on allocation of funds.
2. Advise (utilizing committees) Department of Aging staff on the development and implementation of the Area Plan.
3. Review Area Plan when drafted; review when finalized. Submit recommendation to the Department of Aging.
4. Serve as a "sounding board" -- in assembly, in committees -- for concerns, preliminary ideas and proposals.

Mileage will be reimbursed.
