Council was apprised that sometime ago, the City tendered a grant application to the Economic Development Administration asking for \$560,000 as 70% of a total project cost of \$800,000 for the East Area Storm Drain Project. The project basically is the continuation of the present Cluff Avenue Assessment District Storm Drain south to tie into existing mains near C-1 Basin on Industrial Way and the construction of a storm drain lift station near the intersection of Cluff and Pine. Funds are available for the City funded portion of the work. Staff has reviewed the conditions of the grant regarding the completion of the plans, start of construction and statutory requirements regarding conformance to certain laws and acts of the federal government and feel that there is no problem in conforming to the requirements.

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** That the City Council pass a resolution accepting the grant offer from the United States Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration for completion of the East Area Storm Drain project on Cluff Avenue and authorize the City Manager to execute the offer for the City and any other documents necessary during the life of the grant, including right-of-way agreements.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** Sometime ago, the City tendered a grant application to the Economic Development Administration asking for \$560,000 as 70% of a total project cost of \$800,000. The project basically is the continuation of the present Cluff Avenue Assessment District Storm Drain south to tie into existing mains near C-1 Basin on Industrial Way and the construction of a storm drain lift station near the intersection of Cluff and Pine. 
